

MINUTES REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF HARBOR COMMISSIONERS MOSS LANDING HARBOR DISTRICT 7881 Sandholdt Road, Moss Landing, CA 95039

June 28, 2017

A. CLOSED SESSION

 - d. Board action Motion by Commissioner Jeffries, second by Commissioner Shirrel to approve reimbursement of \$150 registration fee to Commissioner Ferrante to attend Legislative Days by CSDA. Motion passed 4-1-0: Commissioner Leonardini, Shirrel, Goulart and Jeffries voting aye; Commissioner Ferrante abstaining.

K. COMMISSIONERS COMMENTS AND CONCERNS

Commissioner Leonardini inquired about whether there was any progress on dredging; GM McIntyre responded there was an extensive update in the Community Relations Report included in this Agenda Packet which highlighted the efforts to date and the lengthy efforts necessary to eventually obtain permits. Commissioner Ferrante mentioned that at the annual Moss Landing Chamber Awards dinner earlier in the week it was revealed that Moss Landing is no longer the best kept secret but is becoming a destination.

The Board adjourned at 7:35 pm followed by return to Closed Session at 7:42 pm.
